1. Who are our first teachers? What are the first lessons we are taught?
2. Who are the first authorities in the natural and spiritual family? How does the natural reflect the spiritual? Tie this to Proverbs 3:1-4.
3. What is the role of the deacons? How does this type the family?
4. How does this sermon unpack the responsibilities of the Pastor?
5. How does this message exhort the congregation to study the Word?
6. Discuss how Romans 1:30 and 2 Tim 3:2 applies to this age.
7. Discuss the lessons we received on respect and how it applies to the different authorities? What does 1 Chronicles 16:29 state about God?

15. What is the purpose of patience in the family context? How does this correlate to Ecclesiastes 7:8-9?
16. What do we learn about discipline in the Family?
17. What do we learn about chastisement / correction to believers?

18. According to this sermon, what does Godly chastisement prove?
19. How did God display the attributes of a Godly parent in Eden?
20. How should parents display the multi-faceted attributes of God?
