

DANIEL 11:32 And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: <u>but</u> the people that do know {a special group, not everyone} their God shall be strong, and do exploits.

The ministry of Son of Man has three pulls.

The 1st and 2nd pull is part of the unfolding of the mystery of the Godhead revelation in the days of the Son of Man in this day. In this day it is important that the first two pulls are part of the Revelation of Godhead where God is revealing Himself and we must see that.

We must see is not just to attract attention but to attract attention to Who? Who is the one is able to do these things?

Appearing of the Lord

This is part of the Godhead Revelation, and the part of the Godhead Revelation is designed for certain people which Daniel said in the last day they shall know their God.

Therefore, the first 2 pulls are not just to identify ministry but to identify:

- The Godhead
- Elohim
- God in the form of a prophet.

It is the Son of Man in power.

Normally when we talk about Son of Man in power, we don't connect Son of Man with power as part of the Revelation of the Godhead.

But it is that no man can do these things only God.

JOHN 5:19 Then answered Jesus, and said to them, Verily, verily, I say to you, The Son can do nothing by himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for whatever things he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

II CORINTHIANS 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

The 1st and 2nd pull taught and identified to us our God, Psalm 103, the healer and justifier of the elect – the 2nd pull that He is omniscient, the all wise Judge.

PSALM 103:1 A Psalm of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. 2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: 3 Who forgiveth all thy iniquities; **who healeth all thy diseases**; 4 Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with loving-kindness and tender mercies.

Psalms 103 identifies that God is the Lord that heals all our diseases and forgives all our iniquity. And remember iniquity is purged by mercy and truth.

Here we have the God rich in mercy under the Capstone Revelation of Son of Man which is the 1st and 2nd Pull which is the mercy of God.

- Warning is an act of mercy and grace followed with Truth.
- That's how Iniquity is purged according to the Scriptures.
- That Identifies Him or Qualifies Him to be the Judge of all the earth or the Judge of all things.
- If He can Judge all things, discern all things, He Knows All Things.
- Therefore, He Is the Only One who can really be identified as the One in the 2nd Pull, That It Was God Himself.

HEBREWS 4:12 For the <u>word</u> of God is living, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

These two signs were unique signs to identify that God was with Moses and that God was with Brother Branham.

So, it was a double compound meaning given to the prophet.

Amos 3:7 – If the Godhead capstone Revelation is to be revealed it must start with a prophet. EPHESIANS 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: 18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, 19 And what is the exceeding greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his mighty power EPHESIANS 1:20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, 21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: 22 And put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, 23 Which is his body, the fullness of him that filleth all in all.

We now have a knowledge of Him. The knowledge of Him starts 1946. The knowledge of the Son of Man in power God Himself starts 1946.

This true divine revelation of the Godhead must come to and through a vindicated prophet. Must stand "not in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God the Pillar of Fire."

1 CORINTHIANS 2:1 And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellence of speech, or of wisdom, declaring to you the testimony of God.

2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified. 3 And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. 4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing **words of man's wisdom**, but in demonstration of the Spirit, and of power: 5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. 6 However, we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to naught: 7 But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the world to our glory: 8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. 9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. 10 But God hath revealed them to us by his Spirit; for the Spirit searcheth all things, even the deep things of God. 11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

EXODUS 15:1 Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song to the LORD, and spoke, saying, I will sing to the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. 2 The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him a habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.

NUMBERS 20:1 Then came the children of Israel, even the whole congregation, into the desert of Zin in the first month; and <u>the people abode in Kadesh; and Miriam died there</u>, and was buried there.

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147 So, Miriam broke out with leprosy, all over. And so Aaron come, told his sister, said... or come told his brother, said, "She is dying, with leprosy."

148 And so Moses run in to intercede for her, at the altar. And when he did, the Pillar of Fire come down, God. He said, "Go call her and Aaron, and bring them here." And Aaron was in it, too. So He said, "Call them and come here."

149 He said, "If there be one among you," God speaking now to them, "that is spiritual, or a prophet, I the Lord will make Myself known to him. I'll speak to him in visions, and reveal Myself to him by dreams, and--and reveal dreams, and so forth."

He said, "But My servant, Moses, there is no one in the land like him." He said, "I speak with him from lip to ear." He said, "Didn't you fear God?" See, God didn't like it.

Luke 21:27 Look to GOD = Jesus = Serpent = Brother Branham.

Now we want to look at a type here that when the people needed deliverance from their sin, which is a type of the plan of redemption or their Gospel.

What God did He took a brass serpent and imputed it on a pole which represents sin judged.

That represents the Gospel with the blood and atonement of Jesus Christ. So, when they look on the brass serpent they were really looking unto Jesus, which was God's provided way to take sin, which was really looking unto the serpent. Looking unto the serpent in the Old Testament was looking unto Jesus, looking unto Jesus in the New Testament was looking unto the serpent and the brass pole which represents sin judged.

You have this dual meaning in the Old and the New Testament.

But to look unto Jesus or to look unto the brass serpent was to look unto God the deliverer.

He is the one that healed you by causing <u>you to be attracted or pointing you to a certain</u> idol.

He would focus your faith and attention to certain representative.

The brass serpent in the Old Testament and Jesus in the New Testament represented God.

But Brother Branham represents Jesus in this part of the gospel; this is who is being lifted up. Jesus Christ is being lifted up again.

His ministry that God had given him, the work that God had given him.

All of this is being accomplished by God through Brother Branham.

ISAIAH 45:22 Look to me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.

So, when it says look unto me all the ends of the earth, you must be looking at Brother Branham.

And if you're looking at Brother Branham, you're looking at Jesus, if you're looking at Jesus you're looking at the serpent. If you're looking at the serpent, you're looking at God's deliverance for the people.

ISAIAH 45:21 *there is* ...and no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; *there is* none beside me.

That is the fulfilment here now in the ministry of the Son of Man where Jesus Christ is being lifted up once again and people are being delivered through divine healing.

NUMBERS 21:7 Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people.

NUMBERS 21:8 And the LORD said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.

NUMBERS 21:9 And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

The Ministry of Jesus was reproduced in Brother Branham.

God caused us to look at The Veil.

So, when it says, 'looking unto Jesus' or 'look unto me all the ends of the earth' or 'they that look for him a second time',

God caused us to look unto Brother Branham because that is looking unto God or that's looking unto Jesus.

So, we're looking that the 1st and 2nd Pull represents Jesus Christ being lifted up in our midst now.

God must unveil Himself to us, by drawing our attention to look at the veil

He has chosen to reveal Himself in power and through His Word and in human flesh, before we can truly know Him.

So, part of the first 2 Pulls is to reveal the Godhead revelation to us

The Son of Man is the unveiling of God in the form of a prophet. We can tie that back there with the first Alpha part with Jesus.

JEREMIAH 31:33 But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel [we are spiritual Israel]

After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts.

you find here that before He can put the law in their inward parts and write it in their heart, we first know that that's the baptism of the Holy Ghost. So that is what was happening in the Seven Church Ages.

In Seven Church Ages he put the law in their inward parts of their heart in a measure and write it in their hearts

the heart represents the Ark.

the Word represents the law that's in the heart and

that law was sprinkled with blood and

We find the natural and spiritual type here

I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

We're looking here that this is in 2 parts -

- this is in the part where God gives them the baptism of the Holy Ghost.
- Then God unveils Himself that He will be their God,

The only way that He will be their God, and they shall be my people is because He would reveal Himself to them completely.

So, in this verse you can find the church ages plan and the Son of Man plan in here.

JEREMIAH 31:33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

JEREMIAH 31:34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD:

At the end of it when He's finish putting the law in their hearts, He is going to cause them to know the Lord.

He will be their God and they will be His people.

Therefore Jeremiah 31:34 should have been interjected between

'I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts', and 'will be their God, and they shall be my people.

You got to know Him.

So, we're looking here at rightly dividing the Word, it does not come exactly right in order.

You cannot be His people and know your God until first He reveals Himself.

JEREMIAH 24:7 And I will give them an heart to know me, that I *am* the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God:

[That's Jeremiah 24:7 and this Scripture began its fulfilment in 1946]

from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity [Psalms 103], and I will remember their sin no more.

That's justification completely, He does not remember it at all, you are truly justified as though you've never done it in the eyes of God. So here you find Hebrews 9:28 being fulfilled

HEBREWS 9:28 So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and to them that look for him he will appear the second time without sin to salvation.

Jeremiah 31:33. Jeremiah 24:7

Luke 17:30 being understood and the first 2 Pulls there.

This is the promise to the wise virgin [Matthew 25] for the 'all of God' are the children of God. The wise virgins are they who are taught of God.

Luke 21:27 the Son of Man in power, the 1st and 2nd pull starting 1946 is God beginning to teach His children.

- 1. We are taught about life, that life has vibration, that God's eternal life, He is only healer and
- 2. He is the one that knows all things.

So that's what we started to learn in 1946 through the promise of **ISAIAH 54:13** And all **thy children shall be taught from the LORD**; and great shall be the peace of thy children.

JOHN 6:44 No man can come to me, except the Father who hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

JOHN 16:13 But, when he, the Spirit of truth is come, he will guide you into all the truth: for he will not speak from himself; but whatever he shall hear, that will he speak: and he will show you things to come.

- **1 CORINTHIANS 4:5** Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord shall come, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise from God.
