Proper financial preparation means they have been saving for years, honouring the heavy responsibility of the marital covenant long before they enter it. By putting God first in their finances, they establish a spiritual foundation that allows God to bless the rest of their resources. They need to understand the rhythm of running a household, how to budget their money, and how to maintain natural order so that spiritual matters can thrive. Ultimately, this brings us to a sobering reality: the heavy burden rests squarely upon the parents.

When a young couple struggles to maintain order in their home, we must recognize that the true success of a marriage is built upon a firm foundation of good parenting. If we send our children out into the world without teaching them financial order, without building their practical skills, and without modelling a godly marriage in front of them, we have failed to give them the foundation they need to succeed. It is our sacred duty to ensure that when our children leave father and mother to build their own homes, they are fully equipped practically and spiritually to honour the Word of God.

In this end-time hour, God sent a prophetic messenger William Branham, operating in the end-time "Son of Man" ministry to serve as the spiritual "father" to this age. To bring the elected children into full maturity, the messenger of this age brought the "sunlight pattern," representing the perfect, complete revelation of Jesus Christ. In accordance with Malachi 4, his foundational commission was to act as a "teaching rain" that would turn the hearts of the children back to the Apostolic fathers, grounding the elect in the original faith of the early church. He delivered the ultimate doctrines required to mature the elect, which is called the Bride's Message, the Seven Thunders, and the opening of the Seventh Seal.

Just as a young girl cannot take on the heavy responsibilities of wifhood without first maturing, the elect children of the early Church Ages were in a state of spiritual infancy, operating under an incomplete "starlight pattern" where early reformers had partial truths.

These teachings brought the essential "Capstone revelation" to the children:

- Correcting the erroneous teachings of past ages (such as Trinitarianism and Oneness) to reveal the true nature of Elohim and the distinction between the Father and the Son. To bring the elected children into full maturity, the messenger of this age brought the "sunlight pattern," representing the perfect, complete revelation of Jesus Christ.
- Teaching the elect that they are not saved by their works, but that they carry the eternal "gene" of God and were an intrinsic part of Elohim's substance before the foundation of the world.
- He even carried this teaching ministry beyond the grave into the sixth dimension, acting as the "Voice" to break down denominational barriers and teach these exact doctrines to the sleeping saints, ensuring all the elect from past ages are united under one perfect faith before the resurrection.

Just as an earthly father's greatest success is raising a child to become a confident, capable adult, the purpose of the doctrines brought to this age is to lead the elected children into full spiritual **Adoption**. God has intentionally designed the earthly family to serve as a profound shadow of heavenly realities. There is an unbreakable harmony between the natural order and spiritual truth, and every part of the natural home reveals the deepest mysteries of God's relationship with His people.

Through the opening of the Word and the revelation of the Seventh Seal, the elected children's minds are completely renewed. Because they possess the eternal seed, they respond organically to these teachings and take on the very "mind of Christ" becoming a perfect "sacred echo" of their Heavenly Father. In this mature state, the elect no longer rely on the child-like traditions of past church ages; they step into full headship, speaking the open Word directly in true faith, and wielding the absolute authority of the Son of Man.

### **The Bride Possessing the Mind of Christ**

To understand our position today, we must look at where the church came from. During the early Church Ages, the church was in a state of spiritual infancy, operating under a dim "starlight pattern". The spiritual progression of the church is a profound dispensational shift from spiritual infancy to full maturity, moving through phases described as the starlight, moonlight, and sunlight patterns.

**She relied heavily on child-like, "in part" traditions such as physical prayer lines and standard altar calls.** She was comparable to a young girl, and because a little girl is simply not capable of bearing the heavy, sacred responsibilities of womanhood or wifehood, she had to be tutored little by little. God has intentionally designed the earthly family to serve as a profound shadow of heavenly realities. We have crossed a dispensational boundary into the mature Bride Age, leaving those child-like traditions behind to walk in the "sunlight pattern".

In the spiritual realm, the elect believers do not possess any original thoughts of their own; their highest calling is to become a "sacred echo," acting as a pure reflection of the thoughts of Christ. Just as a mature, faithful wife intimately knows the mind of her husband without having to guess his will, the fully adopted Bride perfectly possesses the mind of the Lord. This spiritual reality of the Bride "echoing" the Father is perfectly shadowed in the natural home. They constantly measure and analyze your behaviour, paying special attention to how you act when you are under stress.

The children become a living echo of the parents' emotional self-discipline. Children are naturally highly observant; they are always watching you out of the corners of their eyes. By watching how you respond when you are upset or faced with a mistake, they build a clear picture in their minds of how adults are supposed to behave in society. Home serves as the original training ground, and the daily lives of the parents are the textbook from which children learn. They constantly measure and analyze your behaviour, paying special attention to how you act when you are under stress.

If a parent handles stress by remaining calm, relaxed, and in control, the child absorbs the worldview that the world is a logical, rational place. On the other hand, if a parent is constantly frustrated and angry, the child absorbs the negative idea that life is confusing and highly stressful. By watching how you respond when you are upset or faced with a mistake, they build a clear picture in their minds of how adults are supposed to behave in society. Instead, parents must provide a safe harbour filled with an unbroken flow of unconditional love. Just as God patiently tutored the early church because a little girl cannot bear adult weight, parents must realize that children are not just "little adults".

A child measures their own value by the amount of dedicated time their parents eagerly spend with them, because to a child, the word "love" is spelled T-I-M-E. Children do not yet have the brain development or wisdom to always make the right choices, and learning requires years of trial and error.

When you offer unconditional love, you remove a child's fear of making mistakes, giving them the courage to explore the world and eventually grow into a strong, self-confident adult. Therefore, we must completely abandon the harmful 1930s philosophy of harshly "breaking the will of the child" through destructive criticism, which only leaves children feeling inferior and guilty.

Raising children requires the continuous discipline of setting a godly example year after year, repeating the lesson of good behaviour through your own daily actions. When you practice this patient self-discipline, your children will eventually possess your values and become a pure, resounding echo of your family.

This is the exact mirror of our spiritual adoption. By continually receiving the Word and echoing Christ, the mature Bride steps into an adopted state under full headship. With her mind fully renewed, she no longer relies on the traditions of the past, but speaks the open Word in true faith, wielding the absolute authority of the Son of Man.

### **The Starlight Pattern (Spiritual Infancy)**

During the seven Church Ages, the church operated under a "starlight pattern" and was spiritually comparable to a young, immature girl. Because a little girl is entirely incapable of bearing the heavy, sacred responsibilities of womanhood or wifeness, the church had to be tutored little by little. The messengers of these ages possessed only a restricted, partial light and patterned their ministries after the Apostle Paul. In this immature state, God's primary focus was on changing the church's nature, and believers relied heavily on child-like, "in part" traditions such as standard altar calls, physical prayer lines, and the laying on of hands.

## **The Moonlight Pattern (The Transitional Bridge)**

As the church began to grow, she entered the moonlight or "evening light" phase, which served as a ministry of apostolic restoration. This phase acted as a transitional bridge and a "teaching rain" meant to turn the hearts of the believers back to the original faith of the early Pentecostal church, calling the true Bride out of the fading denominational systems.

## **The Sunlight Pattern (The Mature Bride Age)**

Today, the church has crossed a major dispensational boundary into the fully responsible, mature Bride Age. She has left her early traditions behind and now operates under the "sunlight pattern" (the S-O-N light), which is patterned directly after the Son of Man returning in full revelation. To facilitate this, God sent a specific end-time Elijah ministry to act as a "marriage officer," preparing and introducing the fully developed Bride to the Bridegroom.

This mature Bride Age is characterized by several ultimate transformations: In the Bride Age, God transforms the church through the complete renewing of her mind via the opening of the Word and the revelation of the Seventh Seal and Seven Thunders. This perfect light dispels all remaining darkness and fully corrects the doctrinal errors of the past Church Age messengers. The Bride steps into a glorious "adopted state" under full headship, completely united with Christ.

Just as a mature wife knows the thoughts of her husband, the Bride perfectly possesses the mind of the Lord and no longer must guess at His will. She has matured, she no longer relies on those immature, child-like church traditions. A mature wife knows the mind of her husband. When the Bride possesses the mind of the Lord, she operates in true faith by speaking the open Word directly. She does not need a traditional prayer line or a secondary mediator. She recognizes her position, she knows her covenant, and she stands fully adopted, speaking the Word with the very authority of the Son of Man.

Ultimately, this mature S-O-N light provides the transforming energy and "rapturing faith" necessary for adoption, the transformation of the mind, and the final glorification and body change of the believers.

# The Divine Typology of the Family and the New Creation

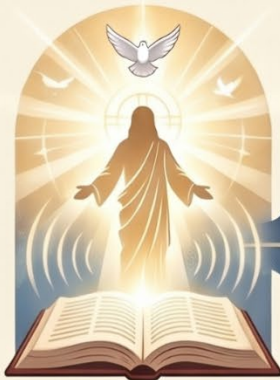
## THE THREE AVENUES OF LIFE



**1: The Direct Creation of Adam**  
Formed directly from "red earth," Adam was a mature son without a woman's womb, yet he was susceptible to sin and plunged his lineage into a fallen state.



**2: Natural Fleshly Reproduction**  
Born in sin through a mother's womb, this avenue allows the "predestinated names" in the Book of Life to enter the world and be called out by God.



**3: The Spoken Word / New Creation**  
Jesus Christ, conceived not by fleshly desire but by the Spoken Word, is an entirely new, higher species—the perfect Kinsman Redeemer for the elect.



## THE DIVINE COVENANTS OF MARRIAGE

**The Spiritual Application**  
Just as a husband may put away a disobedient wife, God "put away" past church movements (like Lutherans or Wesleyans) when they refused to advance with the Word.

**The Male Covenant: Husband as Christ**  
The husband acts as the priest, king, and head of the home, mirroring the authority of Christ over the Church and the Father over Christ.

**The Female Covenant: Wife as the Church**  
The wife represents the Church's submission and faithfulness, strictly responsible for her womanhood, motherhood, and wifehood.

## THE HOME AS A TRAINING GROUND



**The Permanent Audience**  
Children observe parents' daily behaviors and emotional responses [calmness vs. anger] to determine how the world operates and build their future marriages.



**Practical and Financial Preparation**  
Youth must be taught to pay tithes first and care for their "household office" (future home/needs) long before the wedding day.



**Love is Spelled T-I-M-E**  
Unconditional love and dedicated time provide a safe harbor, removing a child's fear of making mistakes and building self-confidence.

## PROGRESSION OF THE CHURCH (The Bride's Maturity)



**The Starlight Pattern (Spiritual Infancy)**  
Represents the seven Church Ages where Believers had partial truth and relied on "child-like" traditions like altar calls and prayer lines.

**The Moonlight Pattern (The Bridge)**  
A transitional "teaching rain" and ministry of apostolic restoration meant to call the true Bride out of denominational systems.

**The Sunlight Pattern (The Mature Bride Age)**  
The "SON-light" age where the Bride possesses the Mind of Christ through the Seventh Seal, speaking the Word directly with absolute authority.
